Her tail was surgically removed, and she was placed in foster care to recover. **CHISPITA** made an excellent recovery, and is no longer incontinent. She does occasionally leave hard pellets of poop outside the litterbox. Because she doesn't have a tail to raise when she's 'doing her business', **CHISPITA** sometimes drips a few drops of urine (this is rare). To minimize these accidents, her foster mom keeps her bob hair trimmed, and cleans her bottom with a moist wipe. **CHISPITA** is very social, friendly, affectionate, and playful. She is a lap cat, and loves to be around humans.
